The **Route 66 Street Legends Tour** is **FREE** and open to all Pontiacs and GMC Trucks, both old and new. Similar to a *HOT ROD* magazine “Power Tour,” you can join along with the procession anywhere, at any time, for as many miles as you’d like. It’s a rolling caravan, cruise and car show... together in one event!

Although this event is sponsored by the GTO Association of America, you need not be a member of the club to participate. We do ask you to please register (*free of charge*) so that we can better plan for the events/activities.

The event officially begins in Pontiac, Illinois following the GTOAA Regional Meet at the Pontiac-Oakland Museum, on Monday, September 17, 2018. Download the official schedule online at www.gtoaa.org (*subject to modification, so be sure to check back often!*) No, you don’t need to start in Illinois to be part of this event; most folks from Arizona will just be participating in the Friday-Saturday-Sunday, September 28-29-30th events.

HERE IN ARIZONA, the three Pontiac-based clubs plan to officially welcome the westbound group when it reaches Flagstaff on Friday, September 28. Our series of activities invites **ALL PONTIAC & GMC TRUCK** owners and enthusiasts to then join along as the **Route 66 Street Legend Tour** caravan continues its journey west towards Kingman, Arizona on Saturday. The event officially ends in nearby Needles, CA on Sunday, September 30th. We invite you to join us for all or part of the weekend’s events!

Yes, the event is free, but you are still responsible for your own food, travel and lodging expenses. You are urged to make your overnight lodging reservations immediately. (Do so right away... you don’t wanna be left out!) You may wish to consider the lodging suggestions (next page) or make your own arrangements elsewhere.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- Step 1:** Download and review the latest Event Schedule and Registration Form at www.gtoaa.org
- Step 2:** Research the overnight lodging options (*see next page*) and make your reservations right away.
- Step 3:** Register with Tour Coordinator Tom Oxler by phone or email, indicating your plans for start/stop locations and the dates of your participation. - Step 4:** Get your favorite Pontiac or GMC Truck prepped and roadworthy.
- Step 5:** Join us at any of the Tucson or Phoenix Caravan rendezvous locations with a full tank of gas!

Route 66 Street Legends Tour 2018 — Tentative ARIZONA SCHEDULE

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 28th

- Tucson & Phoenix Meet-up(s) to caravan to Flagstaff (rendezvous locations/times to be announced soon).
- Pontiac/GMC Truck Cruise-In at Freddy's Custard and Steak Burgers in Flagstaff.
- Bomber Run from Flagstaff to Williams, AZ (30 miles west on I-40).
- "Cruise the 66 Loop" in Williams... Show your pride and cruise a lap or two around downtown upon arrival.
- Check-in to your Williams lodging accommodations. (Note: Red Roof Inn is next door to South Rims.)
- Night Cap at South Rims Wine & Beer Garage, Williams (See their '66 GTO inside the bar area; closes 10pm).

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 29th

- Breakfast on your own (may be offered as part of your lodging?) or, enjoy a special Pontiac breakfast at South Rims until 9am (this breakfast offering has not yet been finalized).
- Depart for westward cruise on I-40 and Route 66 at 8:00am in front of the Canyon Motel.
- Caravan at your own pace along the longest remaining stretch of old Route 66 (between Seligman and Kingman*). Along the way, enjoy the whimsical "Burma Shave" signs and numerous attractions along this two-and-a-half hour drive (130 miles). Perhaps enjoy a quick, late-morning Root Beer Float pick-me-up and photo op at the Hackberry General Store.
- Plan to arrive in Kingman, AZ no later than 12:30pm to participate in the fun, local celebration known as "Andy Devine Days." Enjoy the street fair and family-friendly smalltown atmosphere, with plenty of lunch venues surrounding the car show area. *There is an optional **Car Show** associated with this activity which you may participate in (\$20 entry fee) or you can simply be a "display only" vehicle. - Following the Andy Devine Days Car Show and awards presentation (approx 4:00pm), check-in to your Kingman lodging accommodations and take this opportunity to relax, or grab a shower and freshen-up.
- Later, join us for a very special **Route 66 Street Legends Dinner Event**, hosted by the three Arizona-based clubs. More details to be announced soon; also check www.TucsonMotorama.com for all the latest updates.

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 30th

- Breakfast on your own; depart for home on your own schedule
- **OR**, if you wish to continue along with the **Route 66 Street Legends Tour** as it heads west for the final day of travels to nearby Oatman, AZ and Needles, CA (75 miles), meet at 8:00am in front of the Hilltop Motel.
- The official event ends on Sunday afternoon in Needles. Some participants may continue west towards Santa Monica Pier, others may return home along various routes.) *Sound like fun? Come join us!*
